

Hindi language program, a HPSG initiative, and is now a regular part of mother tongue (MT) program at DIA. The program is run by KHDA approved teacher and is available for children from KG1 to Year 8. With phenomenal support from the parents and school, Hindi MT program is amongst the largest language programs at DIA

India is a land of cultural and linguistic diversity where children speak/read/write different languages. Keeping this in mind, the program is open for all children of Indian origin. Curriculum is tailor-made to suit the IB methodology and is adopted to each child's prior knowledge and capabilities.

Beginner curriculum focuses on learning the basic concepts such as 13 Swars (Vowels) and 37 Vyanjans (Consonants), associated words, simple sentences and numbers (1-10) and advanced student's curriculum focuses on learning higher concepts such as matra's, grammar and maturing the grasp of Hindi language through activity based learning, fun games, role play etc.

The program also covers aspects related to Indian culture, history and way of life. For example - famous Indian monuments & heritage sites, leaders, festivals, freedom fighters, art / dance forms etc. The idea behind all this, is for our little inquirers to be familiar with different aspects of our country.

Hindi MT Class now has its own library that provides reading material for all age groups including material from Indian authors, folk tales and comics!

Program details are as follows:

- Year 1 to Year 6 : 3 lessons of 60 mins each per week (school hours)
- Year 7 & 8 : 3 lessons of 55 mins each, every 2 weeks (school hours)
- KG 1 & KG 2 : 1 Lesson of 50 mins per week (ASA).
